#### Remembrance Day November 11

Sunday November 11, 2018 is a very special date as it is the day that the armistice was signed and World War I ended in 1918. This war had a huge impact on Australia with more than 60 000 killed and 156 000 wounded, gassed or captured. All those who fought in the war have now died with Tasmanian Alec Campbell, the last survivor.

At TPS we will be marking with occasion in various ways including a memorial announcement by student leaders and one minute of silence. Students will be learning about the significance of the day in their classes. We have been very lucky to have one of the 2018 ANZAC "Bears in Schools" donated by Michael Poxon, an ex-Trevallyn parent. It is a unique and beautiful Limited Edition Corporal Cohen Lone Pine Bear. Students are also encouraged to bring along any books they may have of hers and she will gladly sign them at the end of the session.

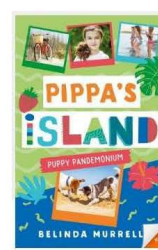
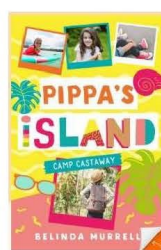
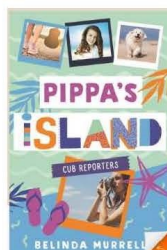
