Oscar participated in the Australia wide ICAS testing that we offer at TPS and his results allowed assessment of his ability to apply classroom learning in new contexts, using higher-order thinking and problem solving skills. This is an outstanding and significant achievement that his teachers and peers are extremely proud of. It was a delight and most fitting that Oscar's parents and many of his siblings could be at this significant celebration and acknowledgement, to witness Oscar's surprise and acceptance.

Students are also encouraged to bring along any books they may have of hers and she will gladly sign them at the end of the session.

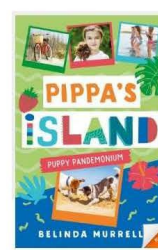
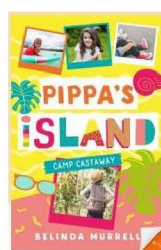
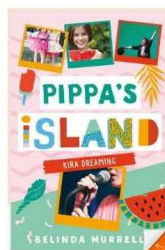
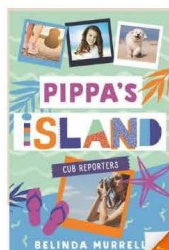

Term 4 update.

School Banking. Helping kids develop savings skills.

Teaching children the value of money in a cashless world.

It's so common now to buy things in a few clicks online or with the tap of a card or phone at the shops. And with little eyes watching, it's no wonder that two in three parents believe that digital/cashless transactions make it difficult for their child to understand the value of money[^]. That's why we'd like to share a few tips that other parents have found useful to show kids the connection between cash and cashless transactions.



Show kids the cost of 'tap and pay'.

When you tap and pay at the supermarket, ask your kids to guess the total of your purchases (from a few multiple choice options). This can help you reinforce that there's a dollar amount attached to the simple 'tap' action.



Show how clicks impact their savings.

It's important for kids to understand that paying for things online has an impact on their savings balance. They can experience this first hand if they pay you back for small online purchases out of their own savings.



Introduce a digital piggy bank.

Consider paying pocket money as a mix of cash and an online transfer. That way children can make the link between coins, notes and online money. As they get older, show them how to check how much money is in their account in the same way they count their coins and notes.
