HAND, FOOT AND MOUTH DISEASE

We have a confirmed case of hand, foot and mouth disease within our school community. Hand, foot and mouth disease is generally a mild viral illness. Common symptoms are blisters that start as small red dots, usually inside the cheek, gums or on the side of the tongue. Children may also have a low grade fever, sore throat and tiredness. Children with this illness should be excluded from school until the blisters have dried. It is advised that if your child develops these symptoms that they are taken to the doctor.






If you are wishing to come along and support us, we would suggest bringing along a chair as there will be limited seating at the pool. The students will be seated in the grandstand.


