Thank you to families for the great support shown in the area of **student health**. Keeping unwell children at home is in the best interests of everyone. We also appreciate our community's ongoing communication in this area.

New information has been shared by our department about **enrolment areas** beginning in Term 1, 2021, after a community review in 2019. This applies to your family if you are enrolling your first child in a Government school for the first time and they will be commencing school from 2021. If you are in this category the updated maps still apply even if you submit your enrolment application before the end of 2020. If you have a child at a government school, the updated maps will not affect you. You can still apply to your school of choice, if the school has capacity. If your child has a sibling already attending a school outside their intake area, their sibling can attend the same school. Our updated maps will not change the way we enrol students who live outside their intake area. This can be viewed on page 5.

It has been really wonderful that some many families have engaged in the **reporting process** planned for early Term 3. In summary, after the impact of COVID-19, we will not be sending a written report. Parents/carers and teachers will have a conversation with the Class Teacher.

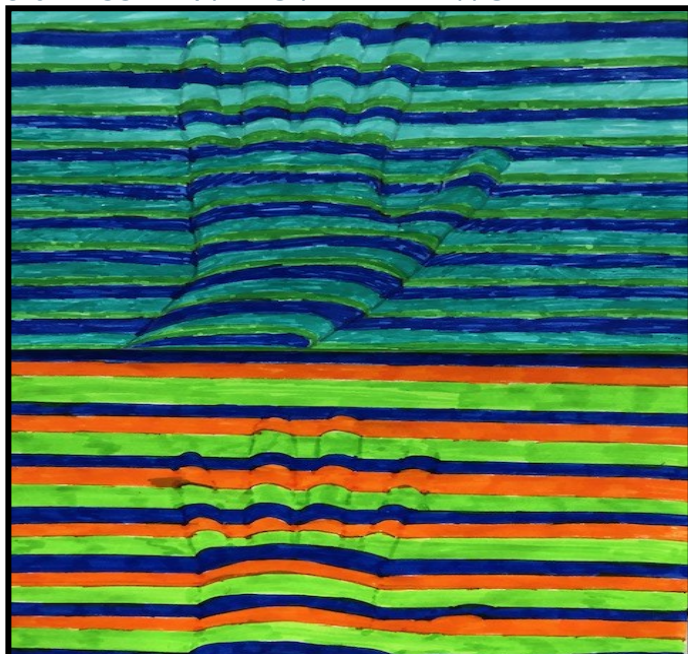

2021 SCHOOL INTAKE AREA

The Department of Education (DoE) has released updated government primary and combined (district) school intake areas, to apply from Term 1, 2021. These updated intake areas will only apply to families **who enrol a child in a government primary or combined (district) school for the first time from Term 1, 2021.**

This means that for parents with children already enrolled in our school, the updated intake areas **do not apply to your family**. If your child has a brother or sister who hasn't started school yet, they can still enrol at our school.

Intake areas ensure that every Tasmanian child can enrol at a high-quality government school close to where they live. Attending a school close to home helps children feel part of their local community. Intake areas also help ensure schools have the facilities and staff to best support their students' learning.
