### End of Year Reports

End of Year Reports will be going home with all **Prep to Grade Six** students on Wednesday 9 December. These summarise your child's overall end-of-year results. Your child will receive an assessment based on the descriptions below for English, Mathematics, Science and Humanities and Social Sciences.

End of Year reports for **Kindergarten** students will go home Wednesday 9 December or Thursday 10 December (depending on your child's days). They include the Kindergarten Development Check markers and are written against the Early Years Learning Framework Outcomes.

Below is a guide to assist you with your understanding of Prep to Grade 6 assessment.

A guide to Understanding your Child's Assessment	
<b>A - Well above the standard expected</b>	The student has an extensive knowledge and understanding of the content and can readily apply this knowledge. In addition, the student has achieved a very high level of competence in the processes and skills and can apply these skills to new situations.
<b>B - Above the standard expected</b>	The student has a thorough knowledge and understanding of the content and a high level of competence in the processes and skills. In addition, the student is able to apply this knowledge and these skills to most situations.
<b>C - At the standard expected</b>	The student has a sound knowledge and understanding of the main areas of content and has achieved the expected level of competence in the processes and skills.
<b>D - Approaching the standard expected</b>	The student has a basic knowledge and understanding of content and has achieved a basic level of competence in the processes and skills.
<b>E - Below the standard expected</b>	The student has elementary knowledge and understanding in a few areas of the content and has achieved very limited competence in some of the processes and skills.

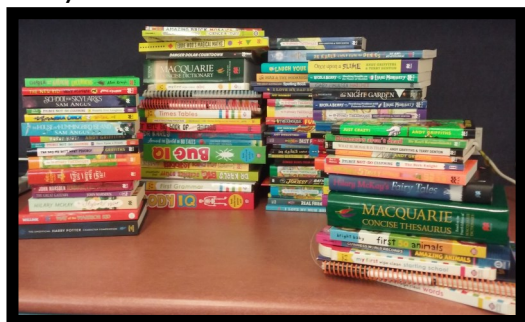
