FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Parent Teacher Evenings

Teacher feedback from our parent/teacher evenings has been overwhelmingly positive. Celebrating children's learning, their progress and achievements have been highlights. Congratulations to everyone involved, we have had most families book in to celebrate and partner with classroom teachers. A tremendous effort.



Duty of Care – Mornings and Afternoons

Each term we are required to remind the community of our before/ after school duty of care hours. Please support by ensuring children are not left in the school grounds when there are no adults to supervise.

Trevallyn Primary School hours are from 8:30 am through to 3:00 pm (front of school supervision finishes at 3.10pm), Class hours 9:00 am – 3:00 pm. It is important that parents do not bring children to school before school hours because there is no supervision of students at that time. Similarly, it is important parents either collect their children at the end of the school day or arrange for them to catch the bus home/make other collection arrangements so that students are not left unsupervised at the end of the school day. Children's safety is our priority and unsupervised students may engage in or put themselves in dangerous positions/ locations. Parents are responsible for their children outside school hours unless they have accessed school based child care during these times.

School Association

Inquiry and Learner Assets

All classes at Trevallyn are working with an Inquiry Mindset.

Part of the staff’s professional learning included Learner Assets. So, what are Learner Assets and how will these help my child now and in the future?

Learner Assets are the future focused skills and processes that are ‘innate human qualities, such as communication, interaction, creativity, innovation and self-regulation (Steele, M. 2021). As a whole school we will be developing and use the language of Learner Assets:

- 2015, Murdoch, K. *The Power of Inquiry* -

We are researchers – curious, courageous, resourceful

We are thinkers – open-minded, flexible, persistent

We are collaborators – empathetic, compassionate, reliable

We are communicators – confident, responsive, respectful

We are self-managers – resilient, responsible, reflective

We aim to deepen our students learning by using the skills and processes to develop understanding of curriculum content and provide opportunities to showcase how students can transfer this deep knowledge through their inquiries.

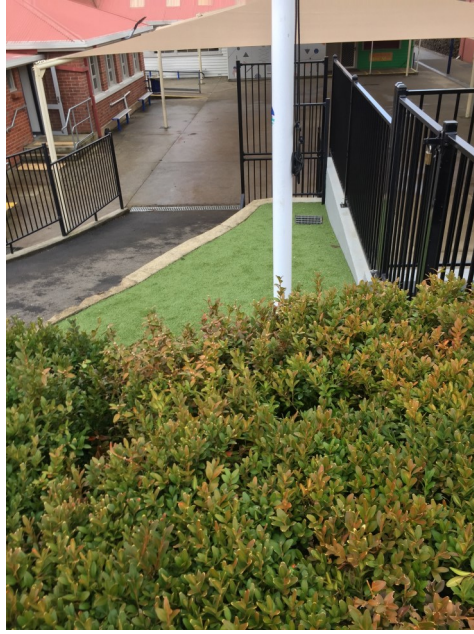


SCHOOL ASSOCIATION

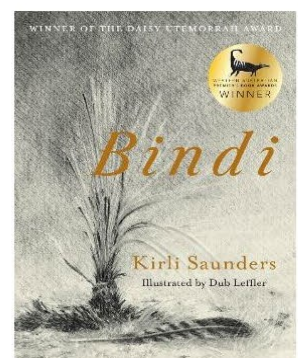
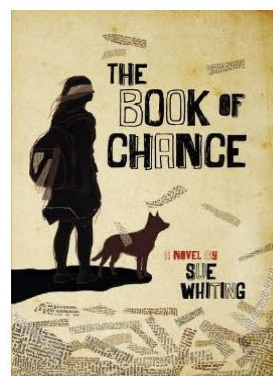
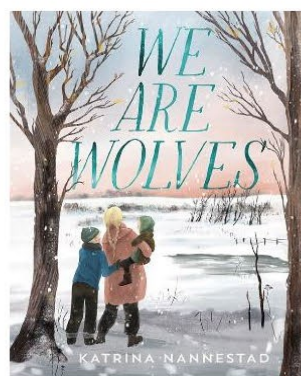
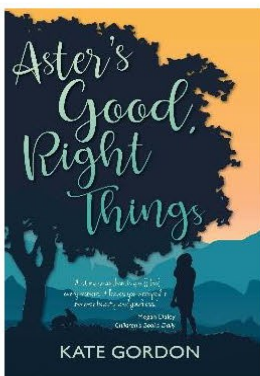
We are celebrating Book Week in Week 6 which is week beginning Monday 23rd August.
