FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Celebrating Learning



Our School Improvement Focus has been on developing student agency through Inquiry and Concept Based Learning. A key learning for us has been developing good questions with and for our students.

When talking to children about their day, it can be tricky to get more than a “yeah good” out of them. There is lots of information available for us to talk to our children, check out this link as a starting point:

A really easy way to start is to ask your children:

- What went well today?
-Aim for 2-3 things (What else? Is a great follow up question)
- Tell me three things you found out that you did not know?
-Tell me more? Is a great follow up question.
- Did anything challenge you today? In your learning? With friends?
-Always follow this up with empathising (recognising emotion is real) and support by being solutions focused. “I wonder what you think is the best way of fixing...)

If you are interested in connecting to the children’s inquiries at school, a really simple way to start is to have a space at home for “wonderings”. Having a spot that you and your children could create a “Wonder Wall” will give them extra practise to create questions about the world around them... Don’t forget to ask them, “I wonder how we might find out?”

Duty of Care – Mornings and Afternoons

Trevallyn Primary School is open from 8:30am through to 3:10pm, class hours are 9:00am to 3:00pm. It is important that parents do not bring children to school before school hours because there is no supervision of students at that time. Similarly, it is important parents either collect their children at the end of the school day or arrange for them to catch the bus home/make other collection arrangements so that students are not left unsupervised at the end of the school day. Children's safety is our priority and unsupervised students may engage in or put themselves in dangerous positions/locations such as car parks being used by buses and cars during school drop off/pick up. Parents are responsible for their children outside school hours unless they have accessed school based child care during these times.

Cold and Flu Season

Cold and flu season has continued with the wet weather. Please remember **if your child is unwell** contact the front office and let us know they will be away. **It is best** that they get the rest and care needed for a full recovery. We are seeing a significant increase in illness across the school for both children and adults alike. When our staff are unwell, they need to stay home also. We are encouraging washing of hands and sanitising at school to be as preventative as we can. Thank you for your cooperation and support.

BOOK WEEK 2021 OLD WORLDS, NEW WORLDS, OTHER WORLDS

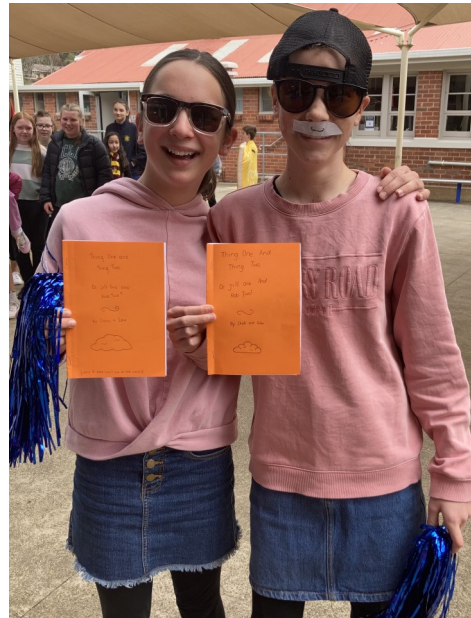
