## 2 OLIVER / BOLZONELLO

### “Will we ever run out of water?”

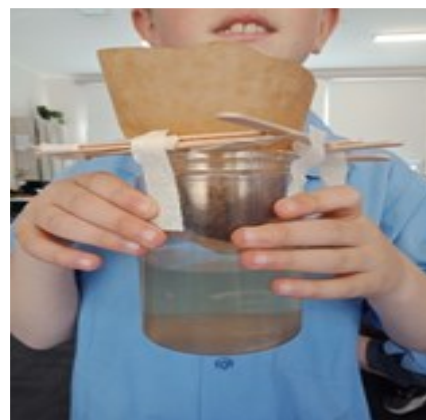
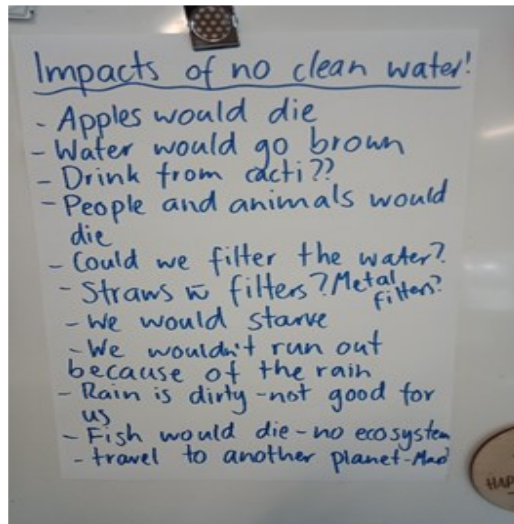
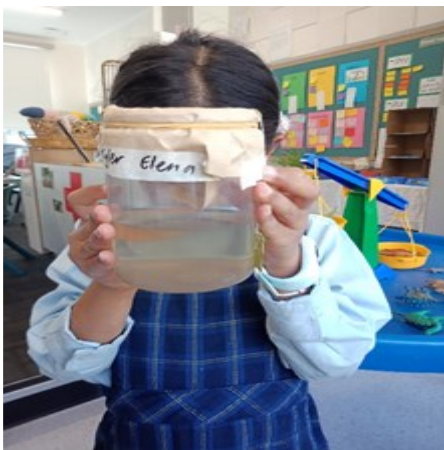
What a great question 2 Oliver Bolzonello asked when we started our inquiry into the natural resources we have here on Earth.

We have been looking at the water cycle to help us understand our question a bit more.

We discovered that we drink the same water as the dinosaurs used to and we have the same amount as we did thousands of years ago. During our excursion to Royal Park to complete the Tamar River Cruise, we discovered the Tamar Estuary has changed over time and the water has become dangerous to drink and swim in. We bought back some water from the Tamar Estuary to examine. We discovered lots of dirt, silt, pesticides and rubbish. We designed and made our own filters to see what materials could be used to clean our water.

The Grade 2's decided that even though we have the same amount of water that we did thousands of years ago, that if we don't look after our water ways and be more sustainable that we could run out of safe, clean water to use.

We also looked at our sky to see how clouds hold water and the change that occurs.

## **Pumpkin Scones**

**2 ½ Cups SR Flour    50g Butter (melted)**

**½ Cup Sugar        1 Egg**

**Pinch of Salt        ½ Cup Milk**

**1 Cup Mashed Pumpkin**

- Preheat oven to 200 degrees and line a tray with baking paper.
- In a large bowl combine all dry ingredients. Make a well in the centre and add combined wet ingredients and pumpkin.
- Turn out onto the bench and knead lightly until combined and not too sticky. You may need to add a little more flour.
- Flatten to about an inch thick and cut with a scone cutter dipped in flour to prevent sticking.
- When putting on the tray scones like to be friends! Have them just touching and pull apart once cooked.
