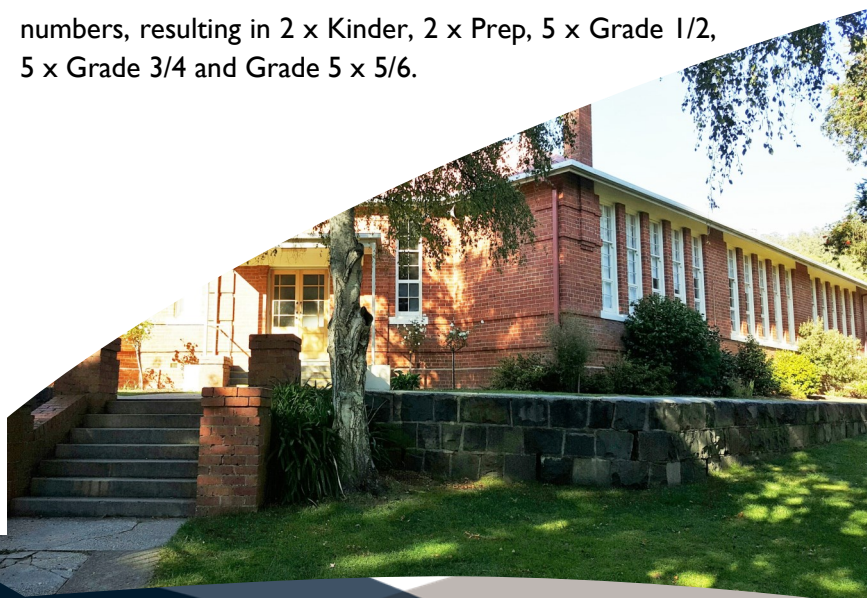
### FROM THE PRINCIPAL

#### The home stretch

As we get closer to the end of the year, reports will be coming home. It is important that we start having conversations with our children about the importance of growth and progress. It is easy for our children to get fixed on A-E grades. The most important aspect of reports is that they see the growth they have made over the year. If you have any questions about your child's learning, please continue to touch base with your child's teachers.

This week we have started to look at class structures for 2022. We have worked on the same number of classes as this year. We know that our students work best when our teachers collaborate and work together. We also wanted our students to be connected across the school. We have set our numbers on the lower side to ensure we can maintain connectedness with their peers and teachers. All classes will be between 22 and 25 in numbers, resulting in 2 x Kinder, 2 x Prep, 5 x Grade 1/2, 5 x Grade 3/4 and Grade 5 x 5/6.

## CRAZY HAIR DAY

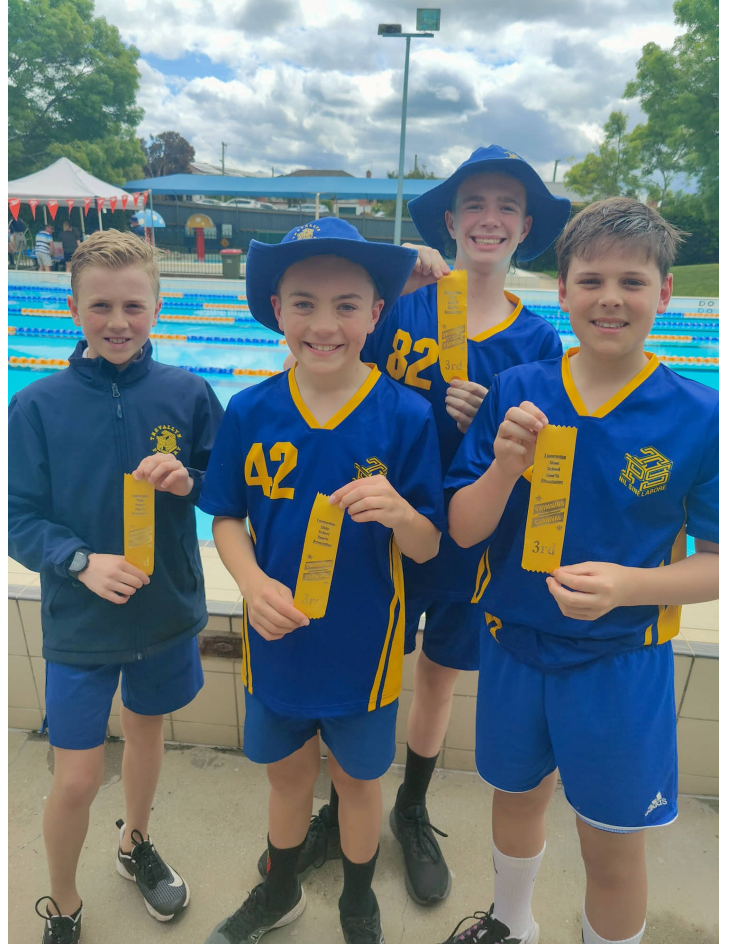
