
CELEBRATING TREVALLYN PRIMARY SCHOOL COMMUNITY

Her hope was by connecting to our cultural heritage and valuing our unique cultural stories, we would build a community that did not tolerate racism. She wanted to build a community that celebrated all cultures. I think what Ari has started is the beginning of future celebrations of this wonderful community.



Next week our student leaders have invited their families and all the experts who have supported them this year to hear about their projects and how they have made positive change.



FROM THE PRINCIPAL...

School Improvement

As the school year comes to an end, it is time to celebrate all our achievements. We have focused on 'Learner Agency' and 'Feedback' to continue to build on our students strengths and provide positive experiences for all our learners. Inquiry and 'bumping up' work has been a feature and can be seen right across the school.

We are so proud of how all students showcase the learner assets across all areas of the curriculum. They embody the values Growth and Aspiration. It is worth noting just how exceptional our students learning and teachers are:

ACER (Australian Council for Educational Research) PAT results for 2021

- In the Progressive Achievement Test for READING 61% of all our students achieved ABOVE/ WELL ABOVE the National Expectation. MORE importantly 89% of our students gained more than a years progress.
- In PAT MATHEMATICS, 60% of all our students achieved ABOVE/ WELL ABOVE the National Expectation. MORE importantly 84% of our students gained more than a years progress.
- Across both tests more than 90% met or exceeded the National Expectation (Australian mean scores).
- We have seen significant shifts in our students achievements in SCIENCE and HASS, demonstrating positive gains in progress across all learning areas.

We are focused on our students engagement in learning, and have much more work to do in this space in 2022 to continue to see PROGRESS. This work is a collaborative process for all of us and we thank each and every one of you who have supported our work this year.

School Events

Outside of the classroom our students have demonstrated Courage by taking risks and having a go. From the Grade 6 students skipping across tree tops to our Grade 1/2 displaying their gymnastic skills, Trevallyn students are always ready to have a go. Recently our students have participated in Dance Fever, the All Schools Triathlon and Esk Band Showcase. It was inspiring to see (and hear) the journey our students have been on since they first picked up an instrument. From learning how to play a single note to being a part of an ensemble in just one year is mesmerising.

Wrapping Up

We have wrapped up our Kinder 2022 orientation this week. Starting school is such a wonderful time for children and their families. It is the beginning of an eight year journey with us, and we are delighted to be welcoming our new students and families to the Trevallyn Primary School community. Many of you will be wondering about the arrangements for 2022. We are in the final stages and students will be meeting their new teachers on Tuesday 14 December (in Week 10). As per our last newsletter our structures for 2022 include Kinder Classes, Prep Classes, 1/2 Classes, 3/4 Classes and 5/6 Classes.


