Thanks Trevallyn Teachers! We love the work you do!


Busy Busy Busy



Grade 3-4 Bender/Fletcher have painted some beautiful budgerigars using vibrant acrylic paints. They have accompanied them with an echo poem. The students collaborated and recorded some main ideas and thoughts about birds and shared their personal experiences, before creating their poem. Birds are an important part of our school environment and we see many species in our bush. Although we don't see budgies, we do see a variety of other parrots. We have particularly enjoyed watching the white and black cockatoos and rosellas fly into the high trees near our classroom. Along with the birds, we are lucky to regularly see echidnas and wallabies. It is truly a magnificent experience to observe the wildlife in our environment.


