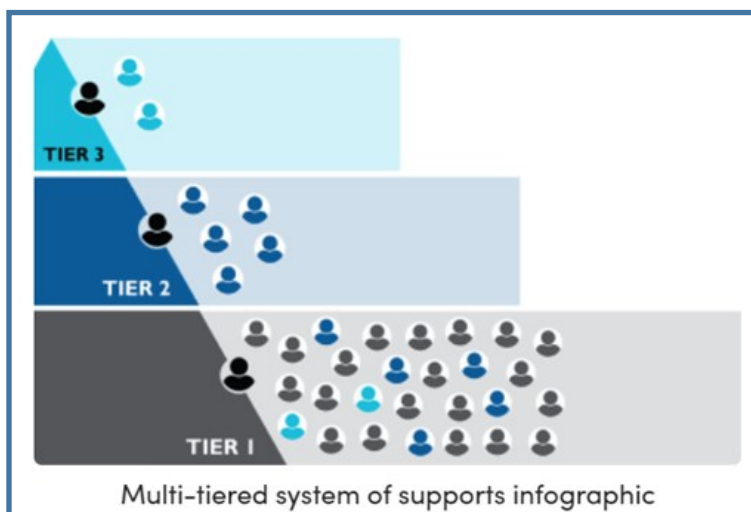

FROM THE PRINCIPAL HOW DO WE KNOW?

Have you ever wondered how your teachers know so much about your child's learning and development? We know they are experts in their vocation, and more importantly they are team players. All teaching teams meet after school, examine student data and plan next steps in learning carefully and with your children at the centre. They plan to find out what children already know, what they need to know, how they can be supported and extended. The Australian Curriculum is delivered through this thorough focus. This is called Quality Differentiated Teaching. Every fortnight, groups of two and three teachers meet with their team leaders in a professional learning team (PLTs). The PLTs analyse student work and evidence of learning. Why?



As a teaching staff we have set high expectation of ourselves to ensure all children grow and progress in their learning. This year we have demonstrated great growth in NAPLAN. In the learning areas of Reading, Numeracy, Grammar and Punctuation we have made outstanding gains; this is due to hard work and close partnership with you.
