FROM THE PRINCIPAL

What do teachers actually do when you're not at school?

Trevallyn teachers and educators have been sneaking up to classrooms in their holidays to prepare and get us ready for learning. The learning environments this year reflect a strong focus on what works best for our learners to be safe, happy and learning. Last week, our teachers collaborated and planned for the beginning of the school year. A big focus at Trevallyn has been engaging our students and learner agency through Inquiry. How can we challenge our good readers to be great writers through Inquiry?

INQUIRY THIS TERM:

Prep – What does it mean to be unique? What is special about me?

Years 1/2 – How do family and community contribute to our lives? How do we change materials without changing their physical composition?

Years 3/4 – Individuals participate in a community and follow rules, how does this contribute to identity and belonging? Living things depend on the environment to survive.

Years 5/6 – The arrangement of solids, liquids and gases relate to their properties. Reversible and irreversible changes can alter different substances. How do changes in physical conditions affect living things and how does the form and behaviour of living things enable survival?

As you can see, there will be a lot of curiosity for Science, History and Civics and Citizenship across our school. Students will explore these ideas and make links to reading and writing skills. Through the students' inquiry they will discover they already have tools with in themselves to be SELF-MANAGERS, COMMUNICATORS, COLLABORATORS, THINKERS, CONTRIBUTORS AND RESEARCHERS. When you are dropping off in the morning, please have a look at our Inquiry Displays, many are outside our classrooms so you will be able to see students thinking and learning throughout the term.




Our school will appear in 'Nearby Locations' if you're within 10kms of the school, or search for our school by name.

If you're within 10 kms of the school, you can select our school from 'Nearby Locations'






HOME
