
# Acknowledgement of Country

# Speaking of our students and their leadership...

Did you know throughout the year our students come to us with great ideas! So far, we have seen our students organise Downball competitions and this week 5-6 Basketball, class vs class. Early this year, a group of 3/4 students came to us with an idea to run a chess club at lunchtime. This week we engaged with a Tasmanian Chess Coach to run an exhibition and he will support our students to run a Trevallyn Primary School Chess Club. Our club has 65 participants for Term 3.

Each year we celebrate and honour students' voice and support them to make their ideas a reality. We have partnered with *Illuminate Education Australia*, who worked with us to design and deliver engaging and intensive education experiences that combine design thinking, entrepreneurship, social and ethical understanding, business and personal development for an impactful learning opportunity for our students.
