The information collected will help in many ways. For example, it will tell us that a certain percentage of students feel like they receive the help they need. Or that a certain percentage feel like they worry a lot. This information will help our school, the Department for Education, Children and Young People and our school community to support young people's wellbeing. Answers are completely confidential.

What is the survey about?

The survey asks students about their:

- school relationships and engagement and learning in school
- physical health and wellbeing
- after school activities

Each group were given 20 pieces of spaghetti, masking tape and 18 minutes to create the tallest tower. Students worked collaboratively and used trial and error to create their structures.

It was lovely to walk around and hear the conversations and see the teamwork happening throughout this activity. The tallest structure was 95cm and used a triangular prism as a base.
