2025 Class Placements - Please read carefully

Trevallyn has a very clear process that honours the expertise and professionalism of teachers, learners' agency and opportunities for families to share new information.

- 1. All students participate in focused activities with their whole cohort.
- 2. Teachers work with students to develop best fit learning friendships.
- 3. Teachers work with students that they will have a new class in 2025, and they will not be with every friend they identify.
- 4. Students identify 4/5 students who they would like to work with in 2025.
- 5. Teachers work together to form potential classes 2025.
- 6. Classes are likely to be Kinder, Prep, 1/2, 3/4 and 5/6.
- 7. Leadership place classes into 'Class Creator' and identify support and extension needed, make considerations from parent requests from meetings with Louise.
- 8. Teachers look at next draft and identify any areas of need.
- 9. Students 'Meet the Teacher' Tuesday 17 December 2024.

As a school we work very hard to set all students up with success. We know we don't always get it right. There are times when we cannot align all the stars. Please connect with me (Louise) so we can continue to improve and support your family as you continue through the years.

We are starting to plan for 2025. We know that most families have stayed very connected to their classroom teachers. Teachers play an active role in placing students for the following year, through working closely with you and your children. They have a wealth of knowledge to support these decisions and will work with children to identify peers.

Throughout the year we know families invest in lots of outside support for children. If you have accessed an integrated service and have new reports and would like to discuss these or 2025 with me, **please make an appointment through the front office.**

You may want to connect with me to discuss your child's placement and I am happy to hear all your perspectives. Please understand meetings with me are **not** for teacher requests or discussions about other students in the school. We base our decisions on class placement on student agency, teacher input and all students' learning needs.

Our class make up is multi-level. This is to support broad connections with peers and other students across the school. This allows support of the Australian Curriculum delivery for each year level and 2-year band, allows us to have options to support smaller class sizes and target intervention and extension. We ensure all students have opportunity throughout Term 4 to have experiences with their own year cohort. We explicitly teach about the transition and set students up with knowing a change will happen for the following year. We give the message to students that we value their input and that we will place them with at least one (in most cases two) friends they have identified.

We need to know from you!

We know there are some families that will be moving on from Trevallyn. If you are planning to move interstate or to another school, we really need to hear from you. Please email Trevallyn Public as soon as possible to let us know your plans.

TOPICS TIP


Q. How can I be sure my child's food order has been received by the school?

A.Qkr! is the safe, secure, reliable way to pay for school food orders. Your eReceipt is confirmation the order has been received by the school.

Qkr! Orders are much more efficient to prepare than cash orders. Ordering with Qkr!: 1. Speeds up preparation time so staff have more time to prepare and serve the food; 2. Reduces time spent on cash handling tasks;

3. Reduces the need for your child to carry cash to school, so no more worrying about lost lunch money.

Qkr! Orders have a cut off time of 9:00am at Trevallyn Primary School. If you have any issues processing via Qkr!, cash orders can be placed in envelopes.
