This term, our Year 5/6 students have been inquiring into the central idea: "How and why do people seek homes in new places?" As part of this exploration, we were fortunate to host special guests from the Launceston Library's **Living Library** program. In this unique initiative, people (known as "Books") shared their personal stories of migration and resettlement.

Our students had the opportunity to engage with individuals who migrated from the Philippines and Italy, as well as refugees from Iran and Afghanistan. These powerful conversations helped challenge stereotypes and promote empathy, inclusion, and diversity. The students demonstrated the learning asset of being **researchers**, asking thoughtful and deep questions that reflected their curiosity and compassion.

It was a truly enriching experience that brought our inquiry to life through real-world perspectives.
