From The Principal

Welcome back to Term 4. We have had a very positive start. Classes are quickly back to focussed learning and being with friends and the great weather have uplifted spirits. The children look wonderful in their summer uniforms. Thank you for the effort in this area.

Be Brave and Shave. What a great article on **Be Brave and Shave** in the *Examiner* during the holidays. With only 1 week to go, the excitement is building! What amazing and compassionate students and school community members we have (68 in total!), to make this the huge success that it is.

Arriving on Time. The first ten minutes of a school day in any classroom outlines the learning activities that will occur during that session and the organisation required by students. Students who arrive late to school miss this opportunity and often find it difficult to settle into the learning tasks. Missing a few minutes each day may not seem like a big deal but your child may be missing more than you realise if he or she is continually late.

Current research shows that mornings for most children are the most productive time of the day, with 10.00am the peak period for productivity. When children arrive late and take time to settle as they inevitably do, valuable learning time is lost.

Please take the time to ensure that your child arrives to school on time. They will definitely benefit from a smooth start to each day!

Building Update. The progress is very pleasing. During the holidays the service trench connecting back to our main building was completed. The external posts for roofing, plus scaffolding and columns for deck were completed. Only nine weeks left now and lots to do!

Class Placement. Thank you to the parents who provided feedback on class placement. We appreciate the time and effort that went into this. With the period of parent input now complete, all teachers and leaders will begin the process of class placement, mindful of the information we have received.

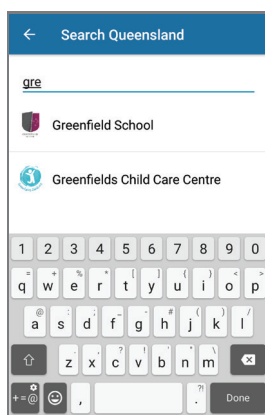
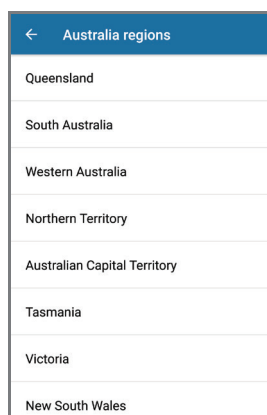

3. Download and install SZapp.

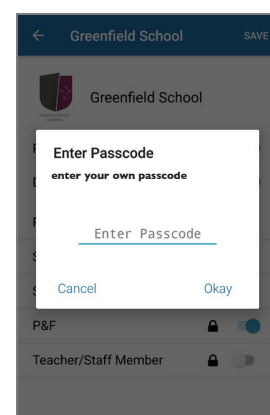
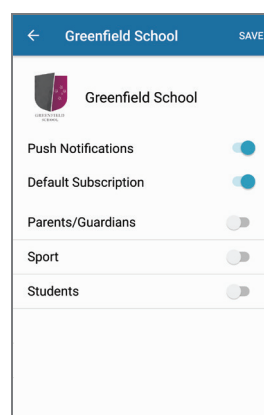
