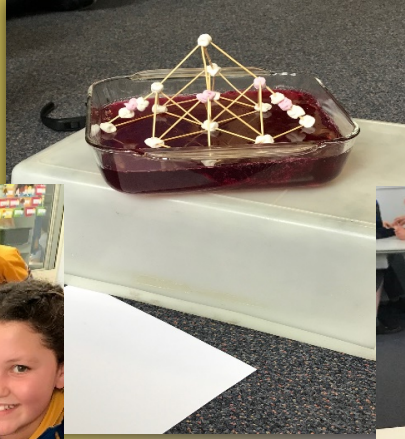

Taekwondo Championships

Building Update

Currently, electrical and plumbing work is occurring and we are ready for roofing. Columns supporting the deck are up. The service trench was installed during the Term 3 break. Soon we will start framing for cladding, plastering and many subcontractors will begin their work. A path connecting to the playground will be constructed on the Student Free Day (November 3). Leon of Lange Design will attend early November for landscaping soil and rock placement. Anna Povey has been very supportive with landscaping planning and advice. We have had no disruption to classes and learning. The completion date goal is 21 December. The site is magnificent. I believe the features will be the site, view, light, ventilation, deck and the associated support areas for the main classrooms. In 2018 it will be greatly appreciated that Music will return to our site and current planning is for Grade 4 to be in the new build.

As part of the Tasmanian Government Art site project, superb artwork by two Tasmanian artists have been selected for display in the new area. These include, two acrylic on canvas pieces by Mandy Hunniford, entitled Flora's Garden and depicting Autumn and Spring and a series of acrylic panels (6 in total) with painted references to a variety of cloud formations, titled Weather Rhythms, by Helene Weeding.

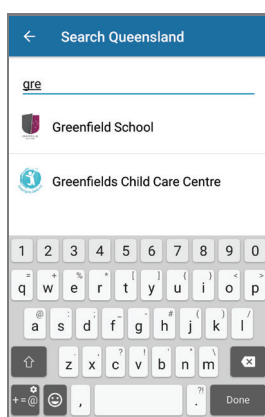
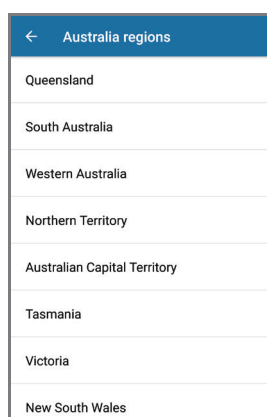

3. Download and install SZapp.

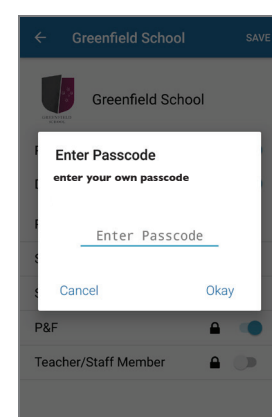
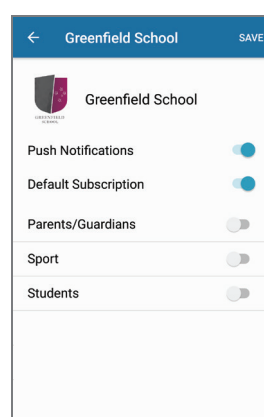

Did you know?

The Tasmanian Government school year is divided into four terms.

Professional learning days

- During the school year, schools have professional learning days and on these days your child will not attend school.
- Professional learning days enable teachers to participate in important learning that improves their teaching.

Moderation days

There is also a moderation day for student assessments. This ensures all students across Tasmania are being assessed against the same benchmarks, and that student assessments are comparable across schools.
