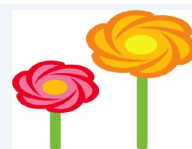

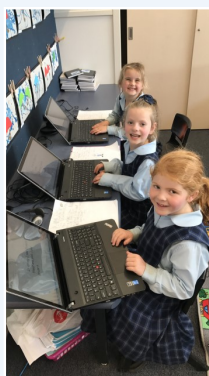

Please follow the instructions in this newsletter to install this application and remove your Skoolbag app.

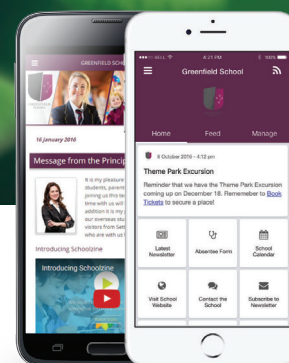

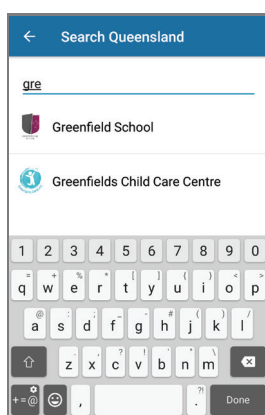
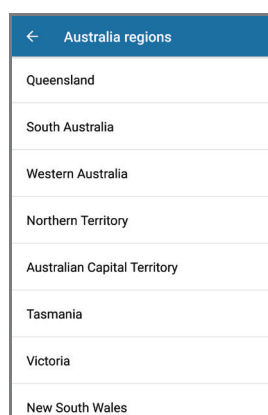

3. Download and install SZapp.

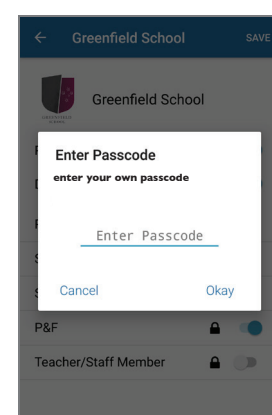
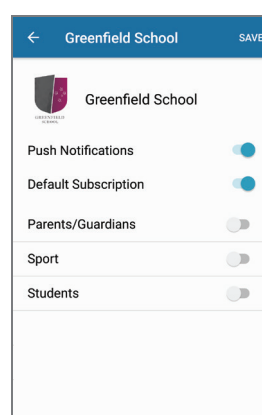

All order forms sent to the office need to have your child's name and class on them in an envelope/snap lock bag.

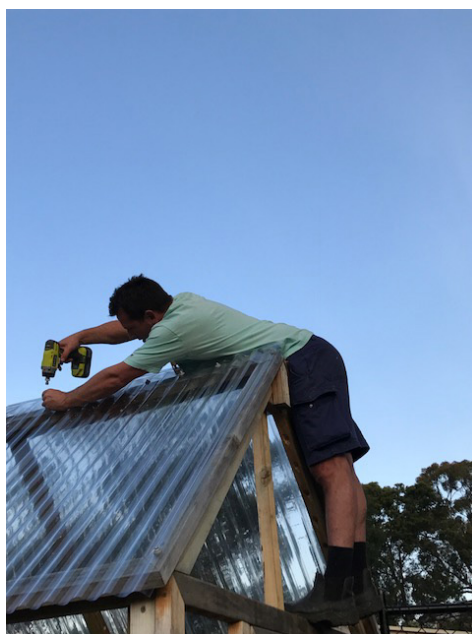


If you are paying by cheque or money order, please make it payable to Scholastic Australia Pty Ltd. (not Trevallyn Primary School).

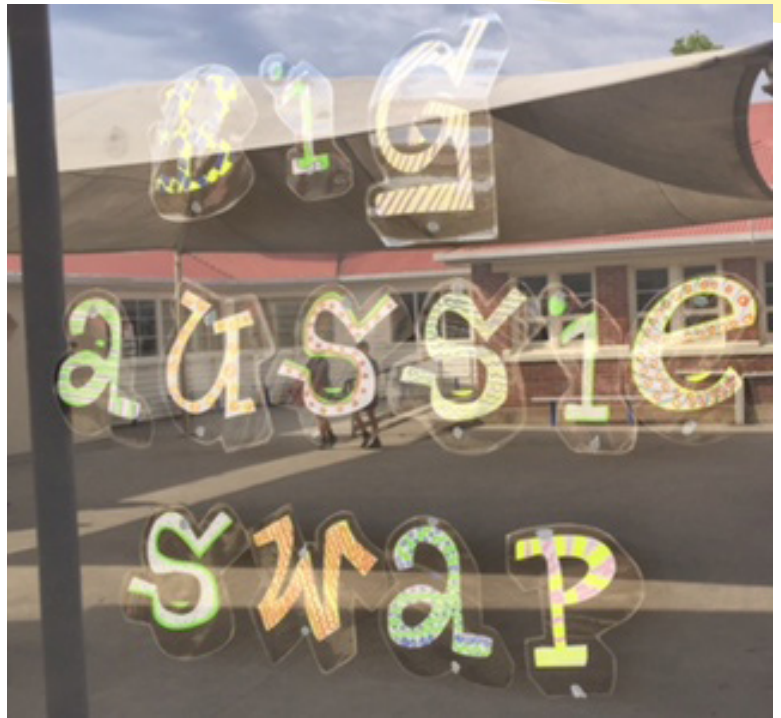
