A big thank you to Ms Stevenson and all of the parents that helped out on the day. The event would not have been so successful without all of your assistance.

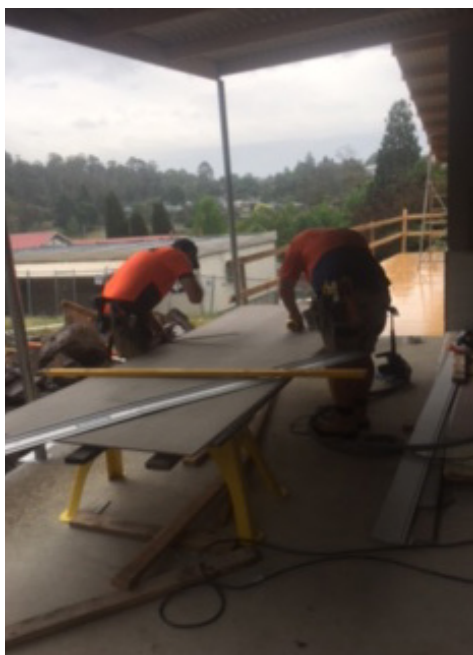
