Learning about Numbers in the Early Years of School

Learning numbers is arguably the most important strand of Mathematics, as an understanding of number underpins all mathematics through the rest of school and throughout life. For this reason, developing a strong understanding of the number system is a priority in the early years of learning.

During the next few weeks we will look at early counting skills and learning place value.

Learning Number Names

Children learn names of numbers before they begin to count. Learning number names (and learning them in order) is important and needs to happen before children can learn to count meaningfully.

Activities you can do with your child:

Sing nursery rhymes that involve counting:

- One, two, three, four, five: Once I caught a fish alive
- Five little ducks
- The ants go marching one by one
- Five little monkeys
- This old man

Hearing you counting is a good way to start as well – so count out loud for your child

- Count out fruit in the supermarket
- Count the pegs when you put out the washing
- Count the socks as you fold them
- Count the knives and forks when you lay the table

Take opportunities to count whenever the chance arises. Once your child knows the number names they are ready to begin counting.
